Supply and laying of pipes of 225 mm diameter and 160 mm diameter HDPE/DI pipes, fittings and necessary accessories in the both sides of the Mathugama–Aluthgama Road to complete the already laid pipe laying, by which the distribution system can be extended to a total length of 10.5 km from Mathugama town to Welipenna Interchange.

Provide pipe-borne water supply to residents along the Mathugama – Aluthgama Road up to Welipenna Interchange and in the by roads where possible to supply water from the Mathugama CTB premises tower head.
